**Franklin Neighborhood Development Corporation (FNDC) News – Angelina Rahimi**

The FNDC has received a TCC planning grant to identify top projects to reduce greenhouse gas emissions and will apply for an implementation grant in the fall/winter. Implementation funding could be millions of dollars. The TCC boundaries for this funding are 12<sup>th</sup> Ave – Florin, Hwy 99 to the Railroad tracks

Current ideas include: electric vehicle charging stations, training for car shops to repair EV cars, free wi-fi in public spaces, digital kiosks for wifi, jump bikes, extending RT shuttle. The FDNC is surveying neighbors and plan to survey additional community members. They have targeted 100 businesses and will be narrowing it down to the top 5 projects.

The block party will be April 27. The current location is 17<sup>th</sup> St, but there is discussion to if the location should be moved somewhere else, to include other neighbors and expand reach.
